

ENERGIA RULES

GENERAL RULES (APPLICABLE TO ALL EVENTS)

Registration: Each team/participant must register in prior to the last date of registration which has commenced from the 1st January 2020. Last date to get registered is 30th January 2020 and the **payment of registration fee must be completed along with the registration itself** and after completion of payment you must carry proof of payment when you reach the registration desk.

Ps: Please inform Team Energia after the payment is done.

ACCOMMODATION:

Accommodation shall be provided only from 6th February 2020 to 10th February 2020. For more details, kindly contact any member of the Organizing Committee with the information on the last page of the invite.

Accommodation Charges: INR 130 per person per day.

Special Benefits: If any college is registering for more than 4 events, then there will be 10% off for the team members in accommodation charges.

Sports Gear: Participants must carry their own sports gears. Such as Jerseys, Shoes, Towel etc. Only equipment such as balls, shuttlecocks, etc. will be provided by the organizers.

NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE (NOC) is must for every college participating in Energia'20.

ID Card: Each member of a contingent (playing and non-playing) must carry 2 copies of passport size photos of his or her college ID, Aadhar Card and copy of 10th marksheet for verification. These will be needed for making temporary ID cards.

Age Limit: Participants' age shouldn't be above 26 years.

Misconduct & Indiscipline: Instances of misconduct & indiscipline will be dealt strongly. Such incidences will make a participant and if need be an entire contingent liable to be disqualified from a certain or several or all the events. The decision of the organizing committee will be final and binding in the regards Substance abuse in all its forms is strictly prohibited inside the CAMPUS of RGIPT, all venues of Energia 2020, all the accommodation and transport facilities provided by RGIPT for the purposes of Energia 20. Any violation of this rule can make an entire contingent liable for disqualification from all the events.

Volleyball (Men & Women)

1. The tournament will be based on International Volleyball Federation rules, unless otherwise modified.
2. Each team of men and women must consist of 12 players and not more than 12 certificates shall be awarded to the team.
3. In the first rounds of the tournament, every match consists of 3 sets, 25 points each. Best of three sets will be the winner of the match.
4. Semi-finals and Finals will be of 5 sets, 25 points each. Best of five sets will be the winner of the match.
5. Every team must report twenty minutes before the commencement of their game.
6. Depending upon number of entries, first match may be qualifier/knockout.
7. Overall the final decision will be of the referee.

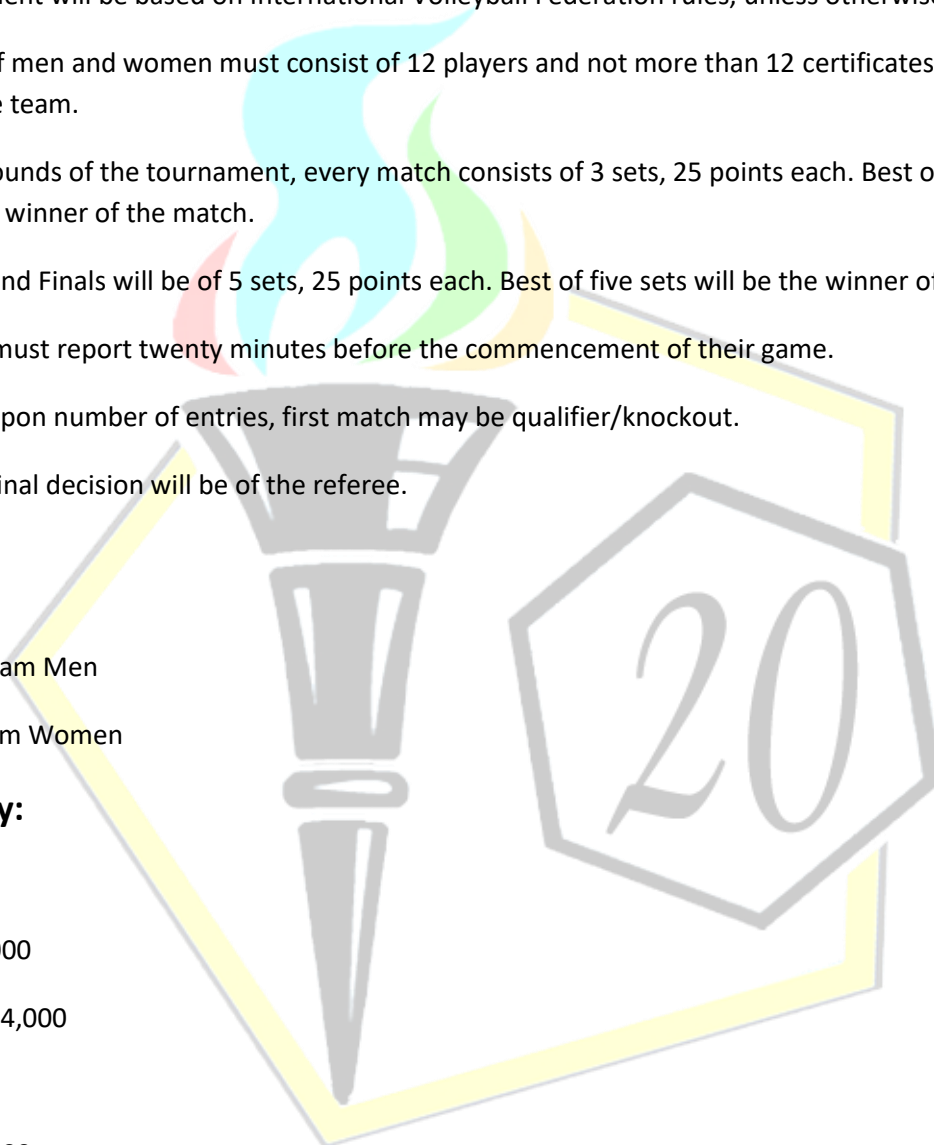

Basketball (Men & Women)

1. The tournament will be conducted according to the International Basketball Federation Rules, unless otherwise modified.
2. Each team of men and women must consist of 10 players & and not more than 10 certificates shall be awarded to the team.
3. During matches if the score is same after the end of the scheduled time, Basketball Federation Rules will be applied, i.e. the game shall continue with as many extra periods of 5 minutes as is necessary to break the tie.
4. If a team is unable to field five players till 15 minutes after the scheduled starting time of the game or if the team refuses to play the match, then the match is awarded to the opponent team.
5. Each team shall report at the match venue 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of their match.
6. Depending upon number of entries, first match may be qualifier/knockout.
7. Overall the final decision will be of the referee.

Kabaddi (Men)

1. The tournament would be conducted according to the international kabaddi federation rules, unless otherwise modified.
2. Each team shall consist of minimum of 10 and 7 Players shall take the ground at a time and the remaining players are substitutes.
3. The team, which scores the highest number of points at the end of the match, shall be declared the winner and will proceed to next round.
4. Each team shall report at the match venue 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of their match.
5. If player/players are suspended temporarily or disqualified from the match, then the team will play with less number of players. Such players shall be counted to award Bonus point.
6. Each Team shall be allowed to take Two Time Outs" of 30 Seconds each in each half; such time out shall be called for by the Captain, Coach or any playing member of the team with the permission of referee. The time out time shall be added to match time.
7. During the time out the teams shall not leave the ground, any violation in this a technical point shall be awarded to the opponent team.
8. Depending upon number of entries, first match may be qualifier/knockout.
9. Overall the final decision will be of the referee,

Kho-Kho (Men)

1. The tournament would be conducted according to the kho-kho federation of India rules, unless otherwise modified.
2. Each team shall consist of minimum of 12 and 9 Players shall take the ground at a time and the remaining players are substitutes.
3. An innings will consist of chasing and running turns which will be of 9 minutes duration. Each match will consist of two innings.
4. The runners and chasers will fix their entry serially with the scorer.
5. The side of the chasers score 1 point for putting out each runner. The team that takes the shortest time to tag/tap all the opponents in the field, wins.
6. Depending upon number of entries, first match may be qualifier/knockout.
7. Overall the final decision will be of the referee.

Lawn Tennis (Men)

1. The tournament will be conducted based on the rules of International Tennis Federation rules, unless otherwise modified.
2. Every team must consist a minimum of two players and maximum four players.
3. Every match consists of 3 games singles, doubles and singles. Every game consists of three sets. The best of three sets will the game. And the best of three games will win the match.
4. Depending upon number of entries, first match may be qualifier/knockout.
5. Every team must report 30 minutes before the commencement of their game.

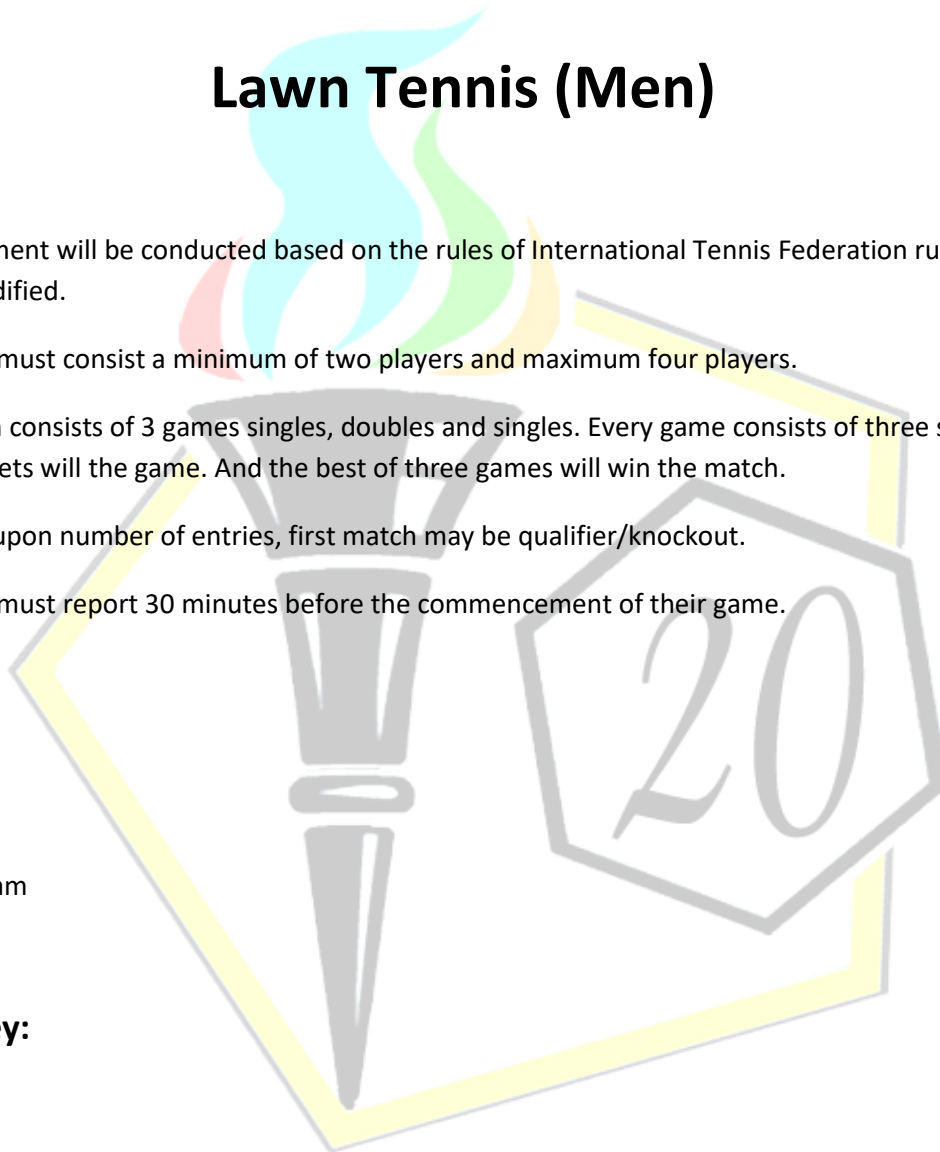

Badminton (Men & Women)

1. The competition shall be conducted under the International Badminton Federation rules unless otherwise modified.
2. Each team of men and women must consist of minimum 3 players and maximum 4 players and not more than 4 certificates shall be awarded to the team.
3. Depending upon number of entries, first match may be qualifier/knockout.
4. Every match consists of three games: 1st singles, 1st doubles, 2nd singles. Best of three games will be winner of the match and result of each game will be of best of three sets (each set of 21 points)
5. Only 1 single player can play a single and double match, the other single player can play only a single match.
6. Winner of the game will proceed to the next round.
7. Overall the final decision will be of the referee.

Table Tennis (Men)

1. The tournament will be conducted based on International Table Tennis Federation rules, unless otherwise modified.
2. Every team of men and women must consist of minimum three players and maximum four players, Maximum one player can be repeated.
3. Every match consists of three games i.n. singles, doubles and singles. Best of three games will be the winner of the match.
4. Every game consists of 5 sets comprising 11 points each. Best of 5 sets will be the winner of the game.
5. Depending upon number of entries, first match may be qualifier/knockout
6. Overall the final decision will be of the referee.

Carrom

1. Minimum number of players in a team is 5 (Combining both Women & Men).
2. There will be 3 ties in a match.
3. The sequence of the ties will be 1 singles, 1 double, 1 mixed double (Total 1 singles & 2 doubles)
4. Each tie will be a best of 3 boards in the initial stages and will change for the finals.
5. 3 points for the queen and 1 point each for black & white carrom men.
6. Each player can play only 1 match
7. There will be no Back-hand striking.
8. Players can bring their own strikers.
9. All players will play using the same powder provided by ENERGIA, RGIPT
10. Depending upon number of entries, first match may be qualifier/knockout.
11. Foul (if valid) will be given only if the opponent claims it.

Chess

1. Chess competition will be played in accordance with the "FIDE Laws of Chess". The FIDE Tournament Rules will be used in conjunction with the Laws of Chess.
2. It is a team event and minimum 4 players are must for a team.
3. There will be no separate tournament for girls, but only a single tournament open to all.
4. All the players of a team must belong to same institute
5. The pairing system used will be FIDE Swiss System.
6. Depending upon number of entries, first round may be qualifier/knockout and out of which teams will be selected for Swiss league.
